

PUBLIC NOTICE AND REQUEST FOR COMMENT

The Wyoming Department of Workforce Services is seeking public comment on a draft of Wyoming's Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP) State Plan (Plan). Wyoming is required to submit the Plan in accordance with Older American Act (OAA) section 503(a) and CFR 641.350.

SCSEP is a federal-funded employment and placement program for eligible unemployed, low-income individuals aged 55 and older. SCSEP fosters economic self-sufficiency, through part-time training opportunities and work-based assignments to increase the number of older persons who obtain unsubsidized employment.
