WHAT IS A SAFETY STAND-DOWN?

A Safety Stand-Down is a voluntary event for Employers to talk directly to employees about the importance of on-the-job safety. This Event focuses on “fall Hazards” and reinforcing the importance of “Fall Protection” programs.

OSHA is partnering with key groups like the Cheyenne Roofing Alliance to raise the importance in preventing fall hazards on work sites. Fatalities caused by falls from elevations continue to be a leading cause of death for construction workers, including roofers. Lack of fall protection remain among the top 10 most frequently cited OSHA standards.

Members of the Cheyenne Roofing Alliance are encouraged to address fall protection safety with all of their workers at tool box or other company safety meetings during this week.
