The roadway construction focused OSHA 10-hour training program includes prevention of safety and health hazards in the workplace, information regarding workers' rights and employer responsibilities.

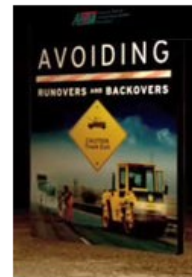
This training helps give employees the information they need to be able to identify and correct hazards they may encounter in a construction environment by focusing on key safety issues, this interactive training will help sharpen participant skills and better prepare them for work in what can be a hazardous occupation.

DOLOSHA course completion cards will be provided to participants upon graduation.



Preventing Runovers/Backovers

This is a comprehensive training program developed to minimize runover and backover incidents in roadway work zones. Course materials cover most information needed to develop and implement Internal Traffic Control Plans (ITCPs) on roadway construction sites as the primary means to reduce runovers and backovers. The target audience for the comprehensive program includes site workers, safety professionals and company safety officers, senior project managers, site superintendents and lead persons. The training is also valuable for roadway owners including traffic engineers and construction managers. The program is designed to be customized for specific audiences by using relevant modules and not using others.
