

Wyoming Workers' Compensation has automated its provider bill review process. We have discovered some services have been denied as a result of the application of the Correct Coding Initiative edits. We have rescinded this application, and will be contacting providers via phone who have been affected. You may see reversal of these denials before we contact you.

The Division will continue to apply the American Academy of Orthopedic Surgeons standards. Those are available at aaos.org.

Please also remember to utilize the modifiers associated with the billing codes, and provide supporting documentation in order to receive payment for services. Current Procedural Terminology code modifiers are listed in the Current Procedural Terminology 2019 book on the inside front cover, and are also listed in the Relative Values for Physicians 2019 book starting on page 8.

The American Medical Association Current Procedural Terminology Codes are another helpful point of reference, and may be found at ama-assn.org/amaone/cpt-current-procedural-terminology.

Other great resources are the Rehabilitation Therapy Utilization Guidelines for the Care and Treatment of Injured Workers, Billing Guidelines, Standards for Content of Medical Records, Chiropractic Guidelines, Preauthorization Program and Treatment Guidelines all of which may be found at wyomingworkforce.org/providers.

Please begin billing with National Drug Codes and not "J" codes or the medication name.

Medical documentation is required to support all charges billed, to include itemizations, invoices, imaging reports, anesthesia reports, etc.
