

CorVel supports the following standard medication formulary. The specific, approved medications within each GPI class are listed below.

Standard Formulary Plan Rules:

1. Generic medications promoted exclusively
2. Brand medications trigger prior authorization
3. Formulary medications limited to 30 day supply, unless otherwise indicated
4. **Medications over \$750 will trigger a prior authorization**
5. **CII Medications and Muscle Relaxers - PA required after 60 days**
6. Combination Medications will be converted to the individual generic products
