

Risk Management Services

Risk Management services are offered through Wyoming Workforce Services – Workers’ Compensation Safety and Risk. This specialized team provides multiple services for the employers in the state of Wyoming.

Risk Management Analysis (RMA)

This service provides the employer’s senior management staff (chief executive officers, chief financial officers, human resources, safety coordinators, managers) with an understanding of their Workers’ Compensation account. During the RMA, the following items are discussed:

- Overview of Risk Management
- EMR, base rate and premium rate explanation
- Injury trending specific to the company
- Claims management techniques
- Discount Programs

A Risk Management Analysis gives the employer ideas on how to be proactive in preventing injuries and methods to reduce costs after an injury has occurred. An RMA will focus on where a company is experiencing injuries and how those injuries will impact the company financially. The Risk Managers will present this information by visiting the employer’s facility, phone conference or video conference.

Loss Run Reports

A loss run report may be requested by submitting the “Employer’s Request for Risk Management Services” form or by visiting piers.wyo.gov. The report includes the following data fields:

- Date of injury
- Claim number
- Claimant name
- Claim status
- Injury type
- Injury description
- Medical costs
- Medical reserves
- Indemnity costs
- Indemnity reserves
- Case total

Risk Management services are ***free of charge*** to all Wyoming Workers’ Compensation policy holders located in Wyoming.
